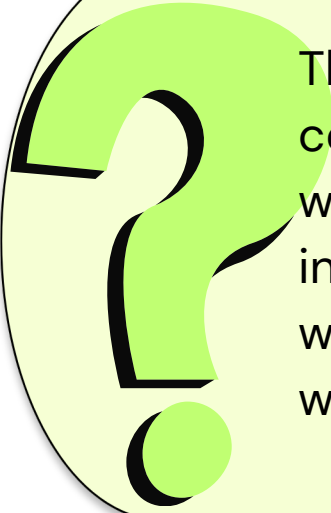


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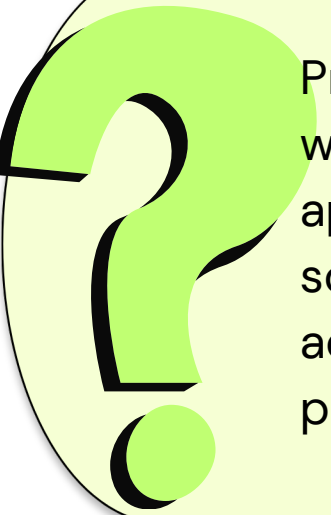

WHY I STARTED INVESTING TIME IN AI



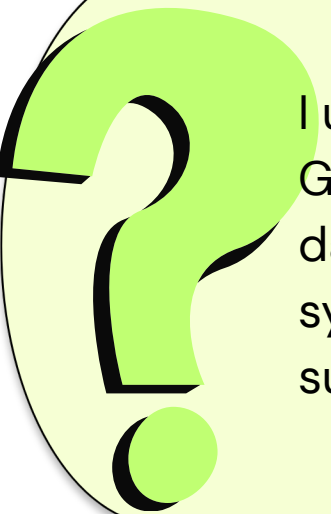

I couldn't responsibly make decisions about workflows, automation, and governance without understanding what was actually under the hood.

WHAT I'M LEARNING FROM PROMPTMATES



PromptMates has helped make AI feel practical by focusing on real-world use cases rather than theory. I've seen how TA leaders are applying AI to operations, reporting, and decision-making, not just sourcing. I'm also learning more about governance and responsible adoption, and I'm currently joining the 6-week AI-native recruiter program to build more structured, hands-on skills.

HOW MY VIEW OF AI HAS CHANGED
